The videos submitted will be what is used to evaluate and determine which students are selected to perform at the convention.
- Students wishing to submit more than one song should send a separate video (link) for each song, and all songs should be appropriate to play during the convention.
- All applicants must be a member in good standing of a chartered FFA chapter in Georgia and have the approval of their advisor(s) by having necessary signature(s) on this form.
- Convention Talent performers will be announced by April 15. Students could be selected to perform in a variety of times and locations throughout the convention.
- Students should be in complete and proper official FFA dress for their performance.
