All entries must fit into the basket. If possible, please wrap with clear cellophane. The bottom of the basket cannot be larger than 3 X 4 ft. A list of items included in the basket must be clearly visible. FFA Chapter or FFA Alumni Affiliate name must be clearly labeled on the basket. Baskets must be in place at the state convention by 5:00 p.m. Thursday to be considered eligible for judging.
