## ENTRY INFORMATION All changes are highlighted.

- 1. Show is open to current FFA and 4H members from Georgia and Florida students in counties touching or North of I-10
- 2. Exhibitors must meet age requirements of Georgia State Livestock Show. **Age Requirements** a. State Market Hog, Steer, Heifer, and Commercial Dairy Heifer Shows An exhibitor must be in the 4th grade or older on September 1, 2019 and cannot have completed high school.
- 3. Entry fee of \$25 per head of cattle. Make checks payable to: *Titletown Showdown Cattle Show*.
- 4. Entry forms and fees must be postmarked no later than **Saturday, November 11th**. Entry forms may be obtained from Agriculture Education Teachers and Extension Agents. Late entries will be accepted for an entry fee of **\$40 per head**.
- 5. Show limited to total of 85 head of show cattle. If entries exceed 85 head, show eligibility will be determined by postmark date.
- 6. Steers will be shown by weight. Heifers will be shown as registered or commercial. Registered heifer division will show by birthdate. Commercial heifer division will show by weight. Top 5 will be selected in steers and heifers.
- 7. Showmanship will be divided by current grade in school. Youth  $4^{th} 6^{th}$ , junior  $7^{th} 9th$ , and Senior  $10^{th} 12^{th}$ .
- 8. <u>PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP</u>- Children age 5 8 can participate in showmanship class for age group. Can show animal of another exhibitor registered in show or own animal. Exhibitor must be accompanied in ring by adult. <u>Entry fee of \$10</u>. Exhibitors of this age group can only show in this showmanship division only and not in regular animal classes.
- 9. Calves must meet the age requirements of the Georgia State Livestock Show. Heifers must be born on or after January 1, 2018. Steers must be born after August 1, 2018.
- 10. Georgia Junior Livestock Shows Rules and Eligibility apply unless specified.
- 11. All animals must be clearly identified with tattoos or ear tags.
- 12. All exhibits will comply with Georgia Health requirements and have current health documents to be eligible for the Show.
- 13. Cattle Show is a "No Fit" Show. No adhesives or paint except for hooves.
- 14. Suggest bring generators electrical availability is limited.
- 15. Any disputes subject to final decision the Titletown Showdown Committee.
- 16. All exhibitors will receive prize money for placing in animal classes. Special awards will be given to the Top 5 steers and heifers, as well as Champion in each division of showmanship.
- 17. Concession stand will be available for food on Saturday.
