#### **Entries and General Rules**

- Livestock Entry Forms shall be mailed to Eric Hickox, Okefenokee Agricultural Fair, 700
  Victory Drive, Waycross, GA 31503 by October 15, 2025. A nonrefundable \$25 entry fee
  per animal.
- 2. Animals will be received at the fairgrounds:
  - a. Swine: Tuesday, Nov. 4, 2:00-4:30 PM (Note: Cattle, Sheep, & Goats may arrive on Tuesday if desired. Let show superintendent know if arriving on Tuesday.
  - b. Goats & Sheep: Thursday, Nov. 6, 2:00-4:30 PM
  - c. Beef Cattle: Friday, Nov. 7, 2:00-4:30 PM
- 3. The Okefenokee Fair Association reserves the right to interpret its own rules and regulations and to determine all matters and differences in regard to conflict on rules.
- 4. The Okefenokee Fair Association does everything it can to protect exhibits, but in no case will it be responsible for loss or damage that may occur to livestock exhibits.
- 5. All Livestock must be owned by and in possession of the exhibitor by September 1, 2025.
- 6. The judges' records are the only guides for paying premiums. The decision of the judges shall be final and no appeal will be considered.
- Feed and water containers will be furnished by the Okefenokee Fair Association if needed. Arrangements for morning feedings must be made with the show chairman or livestock superintendent.
- 8. Cattle must have a neck rope when they are tied.
- 9. Purebred hogs and cattle must send a copy of registration papers with entry form by October 15, 2025.
- 10. All livestock shows are open to 4H & FFA students ONLY. Graduates are excluded from all livestock shows.

- 11. The livestock Committee Chairman has the right to reject or disqualify any entry that is deemed not of show quality.
- 12. The number of entries allowed for each species will be determined by the space capacity of the barn. First priority will be given to exhibitors from the fair's 22 county region.
- 13. The Okefenokee Fair Association reserves the right to adjust classes (grouping of breeds, classes, etc.) at the discretion of the Livestock Committee.
- 14. Exhibitors must exhibit their own animal unless physically unable to do so.
- 15. All animals must have current health certificates that meet the health guidelines for livestock show projects as determined by the Georgia Department of Agriculture. Exhibitors will supply their own veterinarian for any animal health needs that may arise.

Swine Show November 6, Thursday 5:00 p.m. Swine Barn

- Registered hogs will be shown by breeds. There must be at least five animals of a breed to constitute a breed show. If there are less than five animals of a particular breed, they will be shown as Other Breeds.
- Commercial gilts will be shown by weight. Commercial gilts must weigh a minimum of 200lbs. and maximum of 400 lbs. The livestock committee will determine the weights, the number of classes, and the number of commercial gilts per class.
- 3. Market hogs (gilts and barrows will show together) will show by weight. The livestock committee will determine the number of classes and the number of market hogs per class. Market hogs must weigh a minimum of 200 pounds to a maximum of 350 pounds.
- 4. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - a. 1st: \$45
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35
  - d. 4<sup>th</sup>: \$30
  - e. 5<sup>th</sup>: \$25
  - f. 6<sup>th</sup> and below: \$20
  - g. Grand Champion (Breed or Market division) \$60
  - h. Reserve Champion (Breed or Market division) \$55

## Swine Showmanship

- 1. There will be four classes of swine showmanship.
  - a) Pre-Club will consist of exhibitors 4 years through 3rd Grade.
  - b) Exhibitors 4th, 5th, and 6th Grades.
  - c) Exhibitors 7th, 8th, and 9th Grades.
  - d) Exhibitors 10th, 11th, and 12th Grades.
- 2. Any exhibitor may enter one pig in the proper showmanship class, provided that he/she is the owner of that pig.
- 3. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - a) 1st: \$45
  - b) 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
  - c) 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35
  - d) 4th: \$30
  - e) 5<sup>th</sup>: 25
  - f) 6<sup>th</sup> and below: \$20

#### Livestock—BEEF CATTLE

- Beef Cattle will shown by breeds or commercial class. There must be at least five animals
  of a breed to constitute a breed show. If there are less than five animals of a particular breed,
  they will be shown as Other Breeds.
- 2. Large classes will be divided at the discretion of the Livestock Committee.
- 3. Commercial Heifers and Market animals will be shown by weight.
- 4. Cattle must be equipped with both a halter and a neck rope when tied. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - a) 1st: \$45
  - b) 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
  - c) 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35

- d) 4th: \$30
- e) 5<sup>th</sup>: 25
- f) 6th and below: \$20
- g) Grand Champion Purebred Breeding Heifer \$75
- h) Reserve Champion Purebred Breeding Heifer \$60
- i) Grand Champion Commercial BreedingHeifer \$75
- j) Reserve Champion Commercial BreedingHeifer \$60
- k) Grand Champion Market \$75
- I) Reserve Champion Market \$60

## **Beef Showmanship**

- 6. There will be four classes of Beef showmanship.
  - a) Pre-Club will consist of exhibitors 4 years through 3rd Grade.
  - b) Exhibitors 4th, 5th, and 6th Grades.
  - c) Exhibitors 7th, 8th, and 9th Grades.
  - d) Exhibitors 10th, 11th, and 12th Grades.
- 7. Any exhibitor may enter one heifer or steer in the proper showmanship class, provided that he/she is the owner of that animal.
- 8. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - a) 1st: \$45
  - b) 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
  - c) 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35
  - d) 4th: \$30
  - e) 5<sup>th</sup>: 25
  - f) 6<sup>th</sup> and below: \$20

#### Livestock—SHEEP & GOATS

- 1. Goats and Sheep will show separately.
- 2. Market goats and market lambs will be shown by weight. The number of classes and number of animals per class will be determined by the livestock committee.
- 3. Breeding does and breeding ewes will be shown by weight. The number of classes and number of animals per class will be determined by the livestock committee.

Premiums will be awarded as follows:

- a) 1st: \$45
- b) 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
- c) 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35
- d) 4<sup>th</sup>: \$30
- e) 5<sup>th</sup>: 25
- f) 6th and below: \$20
- g) Grand Champion Market Goat \$75
- h) Reserve Champion Market Goat \$60
- i) Grand Champion Market Lamb \$75
- j) Reserve Champion Market Lamb \$60
- k) Grand Champion Breeding Doe \$75
- I) Reserve Champion Breeding Doe \$60
- m) Grand Champion Breeding Ewe \$75
- n) Reserve Champion Breeding Ewe \$60

#### Goat and Lamb Showmanship

- 4. There will be four classes of showmanship for goats (market goats and breeding does together) and four classes for lambs (market lambs and breeding ewes together).
  - a) Pre-Club will consist of exhibitors 4 years through 3rd Grade.
  - b) Exhibitors 4th, 5th, and 6th Grades.
  - c) Exhibitors 7th, 8th, and 9th Grades.
  - d) Exhibitors 10th, 11th, and 12th Grades.

- 5. Any exhibitor may enter one goat in the proper showmanship class and one lamb in the proper lamb class, provided that he/she is the owner of that animal.
- 6. Premiums will be awarded as follows:
  - a) 1st: \$45
  - b) 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$40
  - c) 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$35
  - d) 4<sup>th</sup>: \$30
  - e) 5<sup>th</sup>: 25
  - f) 6<sup>th</sup> and below: \$20
