Dear Coaches and Contestants:

The Auburn University Block and Bridle Club and the Department of Animal Sciences will be hosting a 4-H/FFA Livestock Judging Contest on Saturday, <u>April 3, 2021</u>. It will be held at the Stanley P. Wilson Beef Unit at 500 Shug Jordan Parkway on Auburn University's campus. Check in will begin at 11:00 AM and the Contest will begin at Noon.

**Teams and individuals** are welcome to participate in the contest. The contest will follow 4-H livestock judging rules. Each 4-H club, FFA chapter, county, school, and/or region may have an unlimited number of teams of up to 10 individuals per Team (top 3 scores count for the Team total). There will be a Junior and Senior division. The Junior division is anyone ages 9-13 on January 1, 2021. The Senior division is anyone ages 14-18 on January 1, 2021. We plan to have beef cattle, swine and sheep/goat classes. Senior Contestant will judge six classes, have 2 sets of Oral Reasons and 1 set of Questions. The Officials will discuss placings at the completion of the contest and all contestants will be eligible to receive awards. At the conclusion of the contest, awards will be presented.

The entry fee is \$15.00 per contestant. This \$15 entry fee also includes a snack to be provided to participates before reasons begin (coaches are to bring their own snacks. Please have all participates to have eaten a meal before the contest starts. Entry forms must be postmarked on or before <u>March 17</u>, <u>2021</u>. Any entry forms postmarked after March 17 will require a <u>\$20.00 late fee/per person</u>, <u>no</u> <u>exceptions</u>. If not postmarked by this date, please contact us to allow all contestants the opportunity to judge livestock. According to University Covid-19 policy we will have to cap the number of participates to only the first 50 who we receive registration and complete payment. Since the 2020 contest was postponed this contest will act as the 2020 contest so the ribbons will be dated 2020.
