Dairy Goat Guidelines for Oglethorpe Area Winter Livestock Show:

- Open to 4-H and FFA Members in Oglethorpe, Oconee, Clarke, Madison, Elbert, Wilkes, and Greene Counties. (includes 4-H pre-club, 1st -12th grades)
- This is not an ADGA sanctioned show.
- The exhibitor does not have to be the owner of the animal.
- Exhibitors must show a doe they have entered in this show in their showmanship class.
- Animals must be shown by the exhibitor who entered them unless there are 2 in the same class. Then another youth exhibitor from this show may show the 2nd animal.
- No bucks or senior does. Junior does under 2 years of age and not kidded only.
- All goats must have an official health certificate and scrapie identification.
- Any dairy goat breed as well as commercial will be allowed to show.
- Classes will be divided by age and/or breed type based on entries.
- Other general rules of 4-H and FFA livestock shows will be applied where applicable.
