- 1. Exhibitors in the heifer show must be 4-H or FFA members at time of entry. 4-H members must be 9 years old by the entry deadline. Any student who has completed one quarter in college or is out of high school six months is not eligible to compete.
- 2. Cattle must be the sole property of the exhibitor and recorded in their name with their respective breed association.
- 3. Ownership must be established no later than August 1, 2022.
- 4. **Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in.** All entries, including commercial, must be identified by a legible tattoo and/or tag number.
- 5. All animals presented for exhibition purposes shall be accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate stating that these animals are from herds not under quarantine and are apparently free of all infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases.
- 6. Heifers and steers will be checked in on Friday from 4:00 pm until 7:00 pm and from 6:00 am until 8:00 am on Saturday morning. The barn will be locked and secured at 9:00 pm on Friday night. Show management will assign all stall spaces. **Commercial heifers, market heifers and market steers will be weighed-in on Saturday morning from 6:00 am 8:00 am.
- 7. Exhibitors may not enter more than two calves per class.
- 8. All heifers and steers must be properly halter broken and **lead in a manageable fashion to be eligible** for show. EXCESSIVE force or abuse will not be TOLERATED!
- 9. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than one per class. Any substitute showman must be cleared with show management. A current 4-H or FFA member entered in the show may show the second heifer for the exhibitor.
- 10. Each exhibitor must furnish his own feed, feed trough, water pails, and be responsible for the care of the animal while at the show.
- 11. The show will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit, but will give the best care and attention to prevent loss or damage to any exhibitor.
- Heifer age Classifications will be as follows: Yearling heifer calves: Heifers born January 1 through August 31, 2021 Senior heifer calves: Junior heifer calves: Heifers born September 1 through December 31, 2021. Heifers born after January 1, 2022.

- 13. Breeding Heifer breed Classifications will be divided into Registered and Commercial. There will be a separate Breed show for Percentage Simmentals if 5 or more are entered. If 5 are not entered they will show with the other Simmentals. A minimum of five animals will be needed to constitute a breed show; otherwise those animals will be shown in the Other Breeds category. Commercial Heifers will be weighed & shown by weight.
- 14. Steers will be weighed & shown by weight in Crossbred classes.
- 15. Market heifers will be weighed & shown by weight in Market Heifer classes if there are 5 or more entered, otherwise they will be shown with Commercial Heifers.
- 16. Premiums will be based on entries.
- 17. Breed Champion: Award Reserve Breed Champion: Award Supreme Champion Female: Award Reserve Supreme Champion Female: Award Market Beef Champion: Award Market Beef Reserve Champion: Award
- 18. Showmanship is included in registration and will be divided accordingly. Cloverleaf (4th - 5th Grade) Junior (6th - 8th Grade) Senior (9th - 12th Grade)
- 19. Showmanship premiums will be based on the number of entries.

Entry form must be postmarked by December 15, 2022 with entry fee of **\$30.00** per head including Showmanship. Entries postmarked after December 16, 2022 the entry fee will be **\$45.00** to:
