About Our Show:

Our livestock show is nestled in the foothills of Northwest Georgia, in beautiful Chatsworth, Georgia. Join us for a simple, welcoming show that will be focused on helping others while showing livestock.

This year's show will be a **100% CHARITY SHOW**. Although ribbons and banners will be awarded... payouts will not be given in a traditional way, but as a donation to a specific charity! This year's charities are local school student assistance programs (Bruin Boxes Food Program, the Murray Co. High School Resource Room, and the Colts Closet), the United Way of Northwest Georgia, and the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Greater Chattanooga. All entry fees will be in the form of donations and are \$20 per animal. Each entry fee can be "paid" in \$20 worth of canned food/ dry goods/items or monetary donations towards our 3 chosen charity groups. (For example: 3 show animals= \$60 worth of food or monetary donations, etc.) Be sure to bring your "Entry Fees" with you to the show! (*See list below for needed donation items.)

We will have a t-shirt shop at our show. All materials are first come, first served. The items were very popular last year. Items are made on site! Proceeds from these sales will go towards charity! Get great gear *AND* help others!

There will be a full concession stand available at the show with a FREE COFFEE BAR. Enjoy great food and support our NWHS FCCLA Chapter with their efforts to raise money for charity too!

Rules and Details:

- Check-in 7 AM – 9 AM. Entry fees are paid at the Check-In table.
- Weigh-in 7 AM to 9 AM and the show starts at 10 AM. (Exhibitor Meeting at 9:45 AM.)
- All entries will be in the form of donations and are \$20 per animal. Each entry can be "paid" in \$20 worth of canned food/ dry goods donations or monetary donations towards our 3 chosen charity groups. (For example: 3 show animals= \$60 worth of food or monetary donations.)
- Tie spaces will be pre- assigned. You may arrive the night before. A show attendant will be there all night. Please call **706-296-4510** if you think you will be arriving between the hours of 10pm and 5 AM. DO NOT TIE IN AREAS OTHER THAN YOUR ASSIGNED AREA.
- Show Order:
 - Showmanship- Shown by grade starting with the youngest
 - Heifers by age
 - Steers (shown by weight)

- Show management reserves the right to adjust the show as needed (For example: number of classes based on entries.)
- Exhibitors may show up to 3 steers and up to 4 heifers; \$20 per head
- Exhibitors must be in grades 4-12.
- Registered heifers will be shown by age
 - Registered and Commercial heifers will show for Grand and Reserve
- Steers and Commercial heifers will be shown by weight
 - Steers will show for Grand and Reserve
- **This is a “Blow and Go” show.** NO fitting allowed.
- Wash rack is available.
- Exhibitors may tie to trailers if there is no space left in the barn.
- Bring generators for extra electrical capacity.
- An official health certificate is required by Georgia Department of Agriculture regulation and must accompany steers and heifers. Health papers and registration papers may be subject to be checked upon arrival.
- The show committee reserves the right to disqualify any animal on the basis of health concerns.
- NO Premium money is paid out. Ribbons and Banners may be available. This show is 100% Charity Only! Help others while at this show! :)
- Breed must have 3 entries to make a class.
- Entry forms should be postmarked by December 6th, 2022.
- Exhibitors and guests will be expected to follow social distancing guidelines. Please do not attend the show if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or have recently tested positive.
- Concessions will be available and proceeds will benefit charity as well! NWHS FCCLA Chapter will be hosting concessions and there will be GREAT FOOD available and a free coffee bar!!!!

About Our Charities:

Our Local High School Charity Programs:

The Bruins Box Food Program, the Murray County High Resource Room, and the Colts Closet:

The Bruin Boxes Food Program serves the students of Northwest Whitfield High School to assist with food insecurities. Families are provided with food assistance monthly through this student created, student led program that has been in operation since 2020.

The Murray County High School Resource Room is a place where students of Murray County High School can access needed materials such as food, school supplies, household needs, clothing, and other needed items at no cost.

The Colts Closet serves the students of Coahulla Creek High School as a source of additional food resources beyond the normal school lunch program. Students have access to food items that greatly assist them and their families' food availability and nutritional needs.

Our Local United Way Organization:
