## **First in the Hurst Cattle Jackpot Rules**

- Show is located at the Jeff Davis County Agricultural Complex (Old Fairgrounds) at 248 Kirkland Still Rd Hazlehurst, GA 31539
- Show is Saturday October 26, 2019
  - Check in 8am –10am
  - Show starts at 11:00
  - Show Order
    - Showmanship- (Youngest to Oldest) **Showmanship will be by Grade**
    - Heifers (British, Continental, Commercial)
    - Steers (Shown by Weight)
- Showmanship Grade groups will be decided at show by the show committee according to grades of those entered Junior, Intermediate, or Senior.
- Age Range to Show: 21 and under
- Steers and commercial heifers by weight and Registered heifers will show by age (Born After 1/1/2018)
- Release immediately following the show
- **Entry forms are due Postmarked October 18, 2019(\$20 Late fee per calf)**
- Exhibitor may show 3 steers and 4 heifers
- \$40 entry fee per animal (Covers Showmanship, T-Shirt and Cattle Class)
- Paying 1 spot in showmanship per age group
- No Fitting is allowed
- Exhibitors may have to tie to trailers if there are no spaces left in the barn
- Bring generators due to electrical shortage capacity
- An official health certificate is required by Georgia Department of Agriculture regulations must accompany steers and heifers. Health papers may be subject to be checked upon arrival.
- Premium money paid out according to availability of funds
