~ Rules and Regulations ~

- Exhibitors in this show must be a member of 4-H or FFA at me of entry. Grade eligibility of exhibitors will be based on the current year of Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Shows Rules and Regulations.
- All livestock being exhibited must have an official certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate). This certificate of veterinary inspection must be issued within 30 days of the exhibition. See the current year Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Shows Rules and Regulations for specific information for 4-H and FFA health certificates. No animals will be allowed entry to the show without the proper health records and test requirements.
- Exhibitors must be actively participating in a livestock project and must be the owner of their animals.
- An exhibitor may enter up to <u>FOUR</u> animals per division to show, but may not have more than two entries in any one class in competition for prize money.
- Each exhibitor must furnish their own animals' feed, feed pan, water pail and show supplies. The livestock pavilion will furnish the bedding, electricity and water.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to feed, water, clean-up aer and provide general care of their animals while on property.
- · Veterinarian service for animals while on property is at the animal owner's expense.
- Neither the AgGeorgia Farm Credit, Northwest Georgia Research & Education
 Livestock Pavilion, University of Georgia, Gordon County Extension/4-H, Gordon
 County, Georgia, nor any of its employees are responsible for loss or damage to any
 animal and/or personal property of exhibitor.
- We shall honor the Statement of Relation (Memorandum of Understanding)
 between Vocational Education and the Cooperative Extension which is considered
 the official agreement. This agreement guides 4-H and FFA participation in events.
 The intent of the agreement is to support youth participating in both organizations
 with different project areas and to disallow a young person competing in both
 organizations with the same project area in the same year.

- Registration must be postmarked no later than Friday, December 8, 2023.
- Entry fees are \$20 per animal and are non-refundable <u>LATE ENTRIES WILL BE \$40 PER</u> ANIMAL NO EXCEPTIONS.
- The show will be held at the Northwest Georgia Research and Education Livestock Pavilion at 1286 Highway 53 Spur SW, Calhoun, GA.
- The show committee reserves the right to disqualify any animal on the basis of health concerns.
- To receive premiums the day of the show, exhibitor must be in good standings with all entry fees (on me or late fees) including returned checks.

Premiums will be as followed:

Showmanship:

1st - \$30.00 2nd - \$25.00 3rd - \$20.00 4th - \$15.00 5th - \$10.00

Market/Breed Classes:

1st - \$30.00 2nd - \$25.00 3rd - \$20.00 4th - \$15.00 5th - \$10.00

- All premiums will be paid by check or cash from Gordon County Extension/4-H aer the show.
 - Showmanship Classes: All showmanship classes will be based on current grade in school.
 Showmanship will start with 12th grade and have two divisions per species. The exhibitor may show any one of his/her entries in the showmanship contest; however, any animal which is removed for any reason from the show cannot be shown in showmanship.
 - Market/Breed Classes: Entries will be divided by weight into as equal classes as possible.
 Barrows and gilts will be shown separately and in registered and commercial divisions.
 Crossbred hogs, registered hogs, steers, commercial heifers, breeding ewes, and breeding does will be shown by weight; whereas, registered heifers will be shown by age. Dividing hogs, breeding ewes, and breeding does into classes will be le up to the discreon of the show committee. If possible, classes will be limited to 10 entries per class.
