As we continue to plan for the 2021 Georgia Junior National Livestock Show, we wanted to share some changes or updates offered for the 2021 State Shows. Please understand that this is a fluid situation and can change at any time.

- All exhibitors, Tuesday, February 16 from 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM tack and equipment arrival only. Tie outs only for cattle.
- All Hogs will enter the New Livestock Road (through the pecan orchard).
- All Cattle (Dairy and Beef) will enter the Old Livestock Road (between the Tie-Out's and Sutherland Arena).
- All Sheep and Goats will enter through the east gate (Security Building).
- Pre-ordered/paid Georgia Junior National Livestock Show T-Shirts (ordered online through the GJNLS registration site by 12 noon on Friday, February 5) will be available to be picked up on Friday, February 19 from 1pm-5 pm and Saturday, February 20 from 9 am-12 noon in Sutherland Arena South Concourse Office.
- Complimentary Georgia National Rodeo tickets will not be provided this year. Please be prepared to purchase tickets online starting on February 4 at 9 am from: www.georgianationalrodeo.com. Tickets will be available on a first come, first serve limited basis.
- To ensure the safety of our exhibitors and guests, we will not be able to offer the 2021 Georgia Junior National Livestock Show Banquet. We are working on celebrating and recognizing our exhibitors and donors through a virtual platform in the near future.
- Face Coverings or Masks are required of all individuals that enter a show arena at the Georgia Junior National Livestock Show. All individuals include spectators, exhibitors, judges, and staff. Compliance is necessary and will be monitored by show staff, Georgia 4-H and Georgia FFA leadership.
- Face Coverings or Mask are recommended in all other areas on grounds. Especially where social distancing cannot be accomplished.
- Exhibitors, Family, or staff should be symptom and fever free for a minimum of 72 hours before the event day. Individuals with a confirmed COVID-19 infection, with known exposure to a confirmed COVID-19 case in the last 14 days, exhibiting physical symptoms of COVID-19 or experiencing a fever should not participate and consult with their physician.
- Wash your hands often. Take advantage of hand sanitizer whenever possible.
- Georgia FFA and 4H have developed a substitute exhibitor form to use for students that have to quarantine because of COVID-19 and miss the 2020 GNF Jr Livestock Show. This form must be turned into your specie superintendent by the end of check-in. Please remember all other substitute exhibitor's must be approved by the show superintendent prior to the entered class.
