Polar Pig Classic Show Rules:

- 1. All animals must be checked in and weighed between 7:00-9:00 AM on January 14. There will be no reweighs after the hogs leave the scale area. All exhibitors questioning weights should voice concern at the time the animal's weight is announced.
- 2. All hogs must have an official health certificate and be PRV and brucellosis negative.
- 3. No limit to the number of animals you can show.
- 4. All hogs must have a clean and readable ear tag.
- 5. Classes will be split based on weight. Class will be broken with as many even numbers of entries as possible. Market gilts and barrows will show separately.
- Top Three Breeding Gilts will be selected. Top Three Market Hogs will be selected. Top Three Market Division will be comprised of the Top Three Market Gilts and the Top Three Market Barrows.
- 7. There will not be a weight requirement for hogs.
- 8. The judges' decision is final in all classes.
- 9. Payout will be determined upon the number of entries.
- 10. Show is open to showmen 21 years of age or younger.
- 11. The Coffee County FFA Alumni Association nor anyone or anybody associated with the show are liable for any accidents, injuries, or theft.
- 12. Exhibitors are responsible for his/her own animal and assume all risks associated.
- 13. All exhibitors must be able to exhibit his/her own animal without the assistance of an adult or older exhibitor in the ring, with the exception of Novice exhibitors.
- 14. All exhibitors must maintain continuous full ownership, possession and provide primary care for their animal project.
- 15. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal unless the exhibitor has more than one in the same weight class. Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship.
- 16. Pens are limited and will be assigned as reserved. Exhibitors must provide their own shavings. Shavings will be available for purchase at the show. If pens are sold out when your entry is received, you will be notified and refunded. Hogs will be stalled two per pen where possible; please bring dividers.
- 17. There is limited power in the penning area. Generators are recommended.
- 18. Showing off the trailer is permitted. There is no power in the parking area. Generators are recommended.
- 19. Trailer parking is limited and will be first come first serve. No holding parking spaces allowed. Parking attendants will be directing trailers to parking spots in order to park as many trailers as possible efficiently.
- 20. Show committee reserves the right to make any adjustments to show as they see fit.
- 21. The Billy Walker Ag Center is also a project animal housing facility for Coffee FFA and 4H students, we kindly ask you to be respectful of the other animals in the barn.

The Billy Walker Agricultural Center is a climate controlled barn and arena. Concessions will be available on the show grounds.
