

Guidelines
Madison County Agricultural Fair Swine Show
September 22, 2020, Tuesday – 6:30pm

1. Any exhibitor that has not completed 12th grade is eligible to show.
2. All swine must be blood tested PRV and Brucellosis negative within 30 days of the show and have an official health certificate.
3. Entries will be accepted from Madison County, Jackson County, Oglethorpe County, Hart County, Elbert County, Franklin County, Banks County, and Oconee County.
4. Market barrows and gilts are eligible and will be shown together. Weight limits are 125 lbs. – 275 lbs.
5. Dependent on the number of entries, breeding gilt class(es) will be added. Please indicate on the entry forms. Ear tags will not be required for registered gilts. Ear notches will be acceptable for registered gilts. Ear tags are required for commercial gilts and they must weigh between 150 – 325 lbs. Commercial and purebred gilts may have to be shown together by weight in a breeding gilt class. If the numbers of entries DO NOT justify separate breeding gilt classes, these entries will be weighed and shown by weight in the market classes.
6. All entries must be postmarked (no metered mail) by September 8, 2020. Entry fee is \$20 per pig. Please email your entries to cjones@madison.k12.ga.us and then mail entries with payment to the address below to ensure your entry is received in a timely manner. Premiums are being provided by the Madison County Fair Livestock Committee.

7. There will be no reweighs after the pigs leave the scale area.
8. Penning will be a minimum of two animals per a pen. Single entries need to find a penning partner and designate on the entry form who the penning partner is. Only breeding gilts will be given individual pens. Skip pens will be incorporated to help socially distance in the barn. **Once pens are full, all other entries will be returned.**
9. The barn will be open on Tuesday, September 22th with check in from 2-4. The show will follow at 6:30pm.
10. Showmanship will begin at 6:30pm. Class break-downs will depend on number of entries. Showmanship will start with the youngest exhibitors and continue by age until the final class.
